Look back at the story **Sabīna** to find the Latin for the first sentence in each pair below. Then translate the second sentence by adapting the Latin of the first.

- a. I am Sabina.
(ego) sum Sabīna.
You are Sabina.
(tū) es Sabīna.
- b. I live in the Subura.
(ego) in Subūrā habitō.
You live in the Subura.
(tū) in Subūrā habitās.
- c. The bar is in the Subura.
popīna est in Subūrā.
I am in the Subura.
(ego) sum in Subūrā.
- d. Rufina is working in the bar.
Rūfīna in popīnā labōrat.
You are working in the bar.
(tū) in popīnā labōrās.
- e. Are you sleeping?
(tū) dormīs?
You are not sleeping.
(tū) nōn dormīs.
- f. Father is working in the block of flats.
pater in īnsulā labōrat.
I am working in the block of flats.
(ego) in īnsulā labōrō.
- g. Where are you?
ubi es (tū)?
Where is Faustus?
ubi est Faustus?
- h. I am reading in the room.
(ego) in cellā legō.
Sabina is reading in the room.
Sabīna in cellā legit.

- i. Father comes in.

pater intrat.

I come in.

(ego) intrō.

- j. You are a liar!

(tū) es mendāx!

Is Sabina a liar?

Sabīna est mendāx?
